

Lifeline Services

Low income individuals may be eligible for the Lifeline telephone assistance program which provides discounts from the basic local service and broadband charges through specified governmental programs. Lifeline is a federal program that lowers the monthly cost of phone and internet. Eligible customers will get up to \$9.25 toward their bill.

Lifeline is a government assistance program, the service is non-transferable, only eligible consumers may enroll in the program, and the program is limited to one discount per household.

Toll blocking is available at no charge for low income customers that qualify.
